Arkansas Genealogical Society Announces Prior Birth Index

When completed, the Arkansas Prior Birth Index will index all Arkansas Birth Certificates issued beginning in 1942 to people born before February 1, 1914.

Volumes 1 & 2 index certificates filed in 1942 by people born before 1903.

The volumes include 54,000 names, with birth dates, counties of birth, mothers' names and information necessary to order a copy of the original certificate.

This is a very important resource for nineteenth and twentieth century Arkansas research. If you haven't started your Arkansas Prior Birth Index collection, this is a great way to start!

The Birth Certificates are still being indexed by volunteers from the Arkansas Genealogical Society.

The photograph depicts the portion of the bridge which was built in 1913. At that time, this span covered the bed of the Trinity River. After the disastrous flood of 1949, the U. S, Army Corp of Engineers built the Trinity River Flood Control project which built levees, straightened the river bed, and added an extension to the bridge.
