At the general meeting on January 25, 2011, the professional genealogist John Wylie presented his talk "What the Pros Know". The talk discussed 14 principals which genealogists should follow:

1. Do the census work first
2. Look 'around' each brick-wall ancestor
3. Think like a detective, be observant
4. Watch for abstracter induced errors
5. Keep logs
6. Think locality
7. Become a local historian
8. Take advantage of other people's research
9. Offer to help others
10. Reprove and disprove
11. Discipline is the key
12. Research the record
13. Use timelines. Look for things that just don't make sense
14. Effectiveness trumps efficiency
