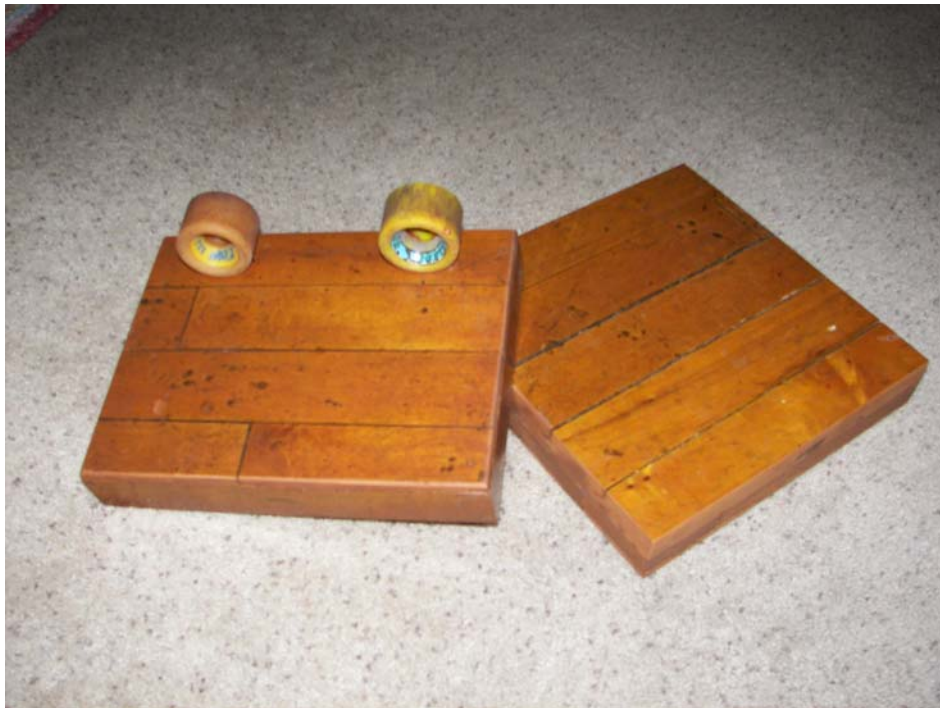


RAFFLE
