Publishing a Family History

Genealogist Pat Gordon presents this full-day workshop on publishing a family history. Gordon discusses how to get started and bring ancestors to life as well as the layout and design of your final product. Writing topics include the types of family histories, citation, documentation and copyright. Design considerations include master pages, headers, footers, paragraph style, fonts, photos, cutlines and a primer to publishing your final product.

As a former newspaper reporter with *The Dallas Morning News* and recently retired journalism lecturer at the University of Texas at Arlington, she especially finds researching old newspapers a favorite pastime. She served two terms as a president and one as vice president of the Fort Worth Genealogical Society. She holds a B.A. in Journalism and M.S. in Media Studies.

Pat spends a lot of time learning about the history and places in which her ancestors lived, and hanging out in courthouses, libraries and university archives.
