The March Meeting

On March 25, the FWGS held its monthly meeting at the Fort Worth Public Library -- Central. Dr. J. W. Sellors, pastor of the University United Methodist Church, spoke about the "Role and Influence of the Methodist Circuit Riders in Westward Expansion".

Dr. Sellors discussed the origins of Methodism in England and how the faith was brought to the colonies. Circuit riding was the Methodists' solution to spread the gospel along the American frontier. A minister was responsible for traveling to all the communities in a region, organizing prayer meetings, and administering the sacraments. He would be able to visit a particular community only once a month because some of the circuits were large.

Mr. Sellors emphasized that the circuit riders were a colorful group. They were deeply religious and dedicated to their work, but they were also used to the rough and tumble of the frontier. He described how one minister wrestled and held a sinner under the water until he agreed to pray — a rare instance in which a Methodist discovered that total submersion was preferable to sprinkling in its redemptive powers.

There were 44 members and guests in attendance.

1930 Census Released

At midnight on March 31, the 1930 Federal Census was officially opened at the National Archives, Southwest Branch. Thirty citizens stayed up into the wee hours to be among the first to research this long awaited census. Al Mirabel, regional director of the Census Bureau gave his perspective on the census.
