## **July Meeting**

On Monday, July 29th, the Society held its general meeting at the Fort Worth Public Library Lecture Hall. The speaker was Judge Stephen King of the Tarrant County Probate Court. Judge King discussed the Probate Court System that oversees the administration of wills. The records are housed in the County Clerk's office and often contain genealogical information because there must be documentation about the heirs before an estate can be distributed. The public can access this information only after a case is completely closed. This may take many years, particularly if it involves a guardianship. In some situations, such as those involving mental disability, the court must open the records, but it does so only for compelling reasons.

There were forty members and guests in attendance.
