Upcoming Regular Monthly Meeting

On Monday, February 23rd, the general meeting of the FWGS will meet in the Tandy Lecture Hall of the Central Library at 7:00 pm. Coffee will be served at 6:30 pm. The guest speaker will be Tom Clark. His presentation will pertain to the social security records and how they can be used in genealogical research. Mr. Clark has worked for the U. S. Social Security Administration since 1978. He is currently a public affairs specialist at the Fort Worth office and is responsible for coordinating public relations activities in the Metroplex. Parking around the Library is free after 6:00 pm. Come early for the meeting and take the opportunity to look over the new materials downstairs in the Genealogy & History area.

January Regular Monthly Meeting

On January 26th, the FWGS held its general meeting at the Central Library. Some forty members and guests were present. Bettye Richardt gave her presentation, "From Legends to Legacies." Bettye has found that while many family members may not be interested in doing genealogical research, they do enjoy knowing about the family's heritage. The trick is to present the information in a way that is more friendly and accessible to them. Typically, the experienced genealogist has notebooks, boxes and file cabinets of pedigree charts, census pages, and other documents. This documentation is essential for the genealogist, but for others it is daunting. Most family member will better appreciate the information is a simplified, digested format. A few of the formats mentioned were: 1) a scrapbook of birth announcements, marriage notices, funeral bulletins, photographs and memorabilia; 2) a compilation of favorite recipes that have been handed down with reminiscences; 3) a video or CD recording of grandmother/grandfather telling some of the old stories; 4) a quilt with blocks prepared by different family members. These items could be shared at the next family reunion or duplicated for family members to keep, enjoy and leave to the next generation. So continue to do the rigorous and detailed research that a good genealogist has to do; but, also think of ways to make a legacy for all of your family.
