If you've dreamed of converting your family history, old photos, documents, movies and videos into fascinating stories to share with your family, this session is for you. You do not need advanced computer skills. Learn how to convert your collection to a DVD by following the easy steps set out in the book, Family History DVD

Our speaker, Becky Volding McLaughlin, is the daughter of Merle Volding, an 81 year old retiree, who wrote Family History DVD. Mr. Volding wanted to digitize his extensive family photo and movie collection but found the project too complicated and costly. To learn the process, he spent time digging through books and manuals full of technical information he didn't need to know. Then he wrote a set of simplified instructions that even the most inexperienced computer user can follow. Becky co-authored the PC version of the book while her father wrote the Mac instructions.
