LostCousins Web Site: A British web site has recently added the U. S. to their coverage in helping you locate cousins. It uses the 1880 U. S. census and the 1881 British and Canadian census at the FamilySearch web site. You enter the information on your ancestors and siblings from one of these censuses and their software automatically searches for others who have listed the same family. When a match occurs, they notify both parties that they have a common ancestor. The common ancestor does not have to be in the 1880 census if the connection comes from a sibling of your ancestor.
