NARA Announces Increased Fees for Reproduction of Pension and Service Records

The National Archives and Records Administration has made the announcement on their final decision on reproduction fee increases, effective 1 October 2007.

- Complete pension file, up to 100 pages: \$75 (currently \$37). Pages in excess of 100 can be ordered at \$0.65 per page.
- Basic pension documents: \$25 (currently \$14.75).
- Military service records: \$25 (currently \$17).

This is a reduction of the price increase proposed earlier and was a response to the input from genealogists (and others) on their fee increase.

Pioneer families of Tarrant County: There are now 9 members of PFofTC. The first five, Joe Ellis Ericson, Doris Ray Taylor, Annie Lee Clark, Deborah McVean and Gladys Wylie were designated as charter members. Since the board reduced the cost of the program earlier this year, there have been four more members approved, Susan McClendon Williams, James R. Blacklock, David Oliver Smith and Ronald Wright. Three more applications have been received and are being reviewed by the committee. Thus, the Board's decision to change the cost and benefits has been successful in increasing the applications. All persons who have an ancestor who was in Tarrant County no later than December 31, 1870 should document that ancestor as being in Tarrant County and become a member of Pioneer Families of Tarrant County. The fee is just \$10 and members receive a certificate that can be framed.
