#### **August Monthly Meeting**

Subject: The Archives of the University of North Texas Speaker: Michelle Mears

Michelle Mears, Archivist of the University of North Texas, discussed the contents of the Archives of the University which are of interest to genealogists. These principally consist of the University Archives, the Rare Book and Texana Collections, Government Documents, and the Microforms Collection. The storage locations are either the Willis Library or the University Storage Facility.

The Willis Library is located on the UNT campus at 1506 W. Highland, Denton, Tx 76203-5017. Visitors to the library must obtain a free visitor's parking pass from one of the several guard stations prior to parking. Offices for all of the personnel are located inside the library.
