Unfortunately, there has been some difficulty which precludes death certificate download. Your editor, among many other researchers, has obtained death certificates (more correctly the scanned images of the same) for many members of his immediate family. What the editor now received is a text message which merely summarizes the certificate. Perhaps whatever caused the problem will be fixed shortly.

Travis also discussed the findagrave project (<u>www.findagrave.com</u>). The site depends on volunteer input for graves. Hence you may or may not be find an ancestor's grave. The site also provides several forums to aid genealogical research.
