We did learn quite a bit about the situation in the colonies during the 17th century. The Austin family came to Virginia early in the century and spread throughout the other colonies as time went by. A constable was responsible for enforcing the legal decisions. Thus, a constable whipped or executed prisoners when so directed by the legal system. A constable collected taxes as directed by the legal authorities. Consequently, constables were persons of some importance.
