

Subject: The Annetta Cemetery and Early Parker County History Speaker: Mickey Hoefer



Mr. Hoefer has been the caretaker for the Annetta Cemetery for seven years. During that time, his duties have expanded from being just responsible for keeping the cemetery clean to being responsible for all aspects of maintenance. He has overseen expanding the grave space, recovering overturned headstones, and adding new and modern facilities. He has accomplished all of this without compromising the country atmosphere of the cemetery.

The cemetery is located in Mapsco Quadrant 758U. To get to the cemetery, go to Exit 415 of IH20. Turn south on FM5. It is positioned half way between the intersections of Annetta-Center Point Road and Airport Road with O'Neal Road (also called FM5). The distance from IH20 to the cemetery is about 2.7 miles.
