#### **November General Meeting**

James "Rusty" Brenner discussed how his firm, Texas Cemetery Restoration LLC, restores cemeteries. This work includes repairing broken headstones, surveying the cemetery for unused spaces, and unmarked graves. Rusty described how the firm employs GPS data to prepare a map of the cemetery. In addition, he summarized how the company uses Ground Penetrating Radar to locate unmarked graves. Their GPS data has a higher resolution than what is generally available to the public. Their GPR readings only go to a depth which is somewhat more that is usually found in graveyard.
