## **Past Genealogical Events**

### 1940 Census Now Complete

The editor received an email from ancestry.com which states as follows:

The complete 1940 U.S. Census index is ready to search on Ancestry.com. Come look for a parent, grandparent—maybe even yourself—in every state and territory. And it is free.

#### 2012 Summer Seminar

Another successful seminar is now complete. Our presenter was Lloyd Bockstruck who is a nationally known genealogy researcher. He used examples from his own searches to show how genealogy and history are bound together. Also, some discoveries are made by pure chance.

#### July General Meeting

The speaker at the July General Meeting was Kimberly Johnson who spoke on "Preservation on a Budget". She is the Coordinator for the Archives of Texas Woman's University in Denton.

One of the more critical problems in preservation lies in reading microfilm. Although black and white photographs have the reputation of being long lasting, the same cannot be said for photographs of printed texts. This is especially true of microfilm images when the operator is trying to get as many images as possible per day.

She recommends using ordinary copy paper to duplicate text data. The general recommendation is to save photographs to matte finish paper (a source is Red River Paper in Dallas). To save space, one can use double sided matte paper to get two images per sheet. Trying to use copy paper for this task results in excessive bleed through.

She discussed various ways to add titles to photographs. The best way, in my opinion, is to imbed the title within the photograph. This task is easy to accomplish with a photograph processing program, such as Photoshop. Once imbedded correctly, the title is very difficult to remove.
