research after inheriting all those post-Civil war era family photos. Along the way she found an early Texas ancestor and a revolutionary war ancestor.

# LDS CHURCH ANNOUNCES END TO MICROFILM LOAN PROGRAMS

On June 26, the LDS Church announced the end to their 80 year loan program by September 1, 2017. That makes **August 31**<sup>st</sup> **the last day to order** microfilms or microfiche from your local Family History Center. The program began in 1938 when the church began filming records around the world. **The reason to stop? Progress in the DIGITIZATION efforts.** The conversion process is due to be finished in **2020**. **So why quit early?** Most everything digitized, is already available online in 3 places. *More on that below.* 

All current filming is done digitally to go straight into use online. In fact, a huge camera replacement push occurred to get better equipment into the field. And all conversion of older microfilms to digitization is being done with the best cameras and to high standards.

The church has amassed 2.4 MILLION rolls of microfilm since beginning. To date, that includes 1.5 BILLION images (or pages) that have been reproduced digitally and available to patrons around the world. Most genealogists have heard of the "Granite Mountain" in Utah. The masters or originals of the films will continue to be preserved there, in their famous storage, to be preserved for all time.

What will happen to films already on-loan at your local Family History Center? Probably nothing. But, call to see what your center says. Each local will have leeway in their policies. Some items will be deemed surplus and could be returned to Utah or given away.

Where to find these records? Go to the website, www.FamilySearch.org You can search under (1) Historical Records (by name or by images), (2) search digital copies of Books, and (3) search Catalog to see what is available digitally. To download & print a 2 pg "cheat sheet" click here & print to keep by your computer.


