

**Ce Ce Moore** is one of the leading DNA experts, not only just for genetic genealogy purposes but for crime fighting purposes. Chances are you have seen her on TV recently speaking on her consultation with law enforcement

officials or reuniting lost family members. She has been with Henry Louis Gates, Jr. on PBS' Finding Your Roots since 2013. This show certainly was one of the first to not only trace your tree, but discuss your genetic components too. She was co-founder of the *Institute for* Genetic Genealogy and has written the popular blog Your Genetic Genealogist since 2010. She also formed the DNA forum called DNA Detectives on Facebook which boasts 92.000 followers. She is also influential in setting genealogical DNA standards for the industry. There is not room enough here to list all her DNA and genealogy related successes, but I did want to call your attention to CeCe for your own LEARNING PURPOSES. 
