Not only did he tell us about the story of how Channel 5 discovered so much material that had been kept in storage since the station began in 1948, but their efforts to have it preserved and digitized. What is available is free to the public on the **Portal to Texas History** at UNT in Denton. There are scripts, promos, videos, stories, posters, and more. Much is searchable by topics, keywords, dates and names.

In addition to the archives, he told of the history on Amon Carter and how the station came to be. Did you know that WBAP (the original call letters) stood for <u>We Bring A</u> <u>P</u>rogram? He even had a little trivia Quiz and gave a few prizes. 
