System (PCS) Committee Chair. He, with his wife Barb, operated a professional genealogy business for 25 years in North Texas. John spent 26 years in the USAF as a Medical Service Corps officer retiring in 1990.

One of five co-founders of GenTech, John was President for 5 years and chaired 3 national conferences for that organization before it was merged into the National Genealogical Society. He served on the GenTech Data Model Working Group which developed the first open source data model of the genealogical process that is still used by many software developers. He served the Association of Professional Genealogists on the Board for 6 years, including 4 as Secretary. He has presented more than two hundred lectures at national, state and local seminars and conferences. John has authored or co-authored more than 25 articles in state and national publications. In local Societies, he has served GPGS as President for one year and Library Liaison for 10 years. In DGS, John served in a

variety of board positions in the 1990's. He was awarded the Lloyd **Bockstruck Distinguished Service** Award by DGS in 2004.

November Veteran's Salute



Two disturbing news stories have detailed the arrest, conviction and recently the sentencing of a researcher who stole items from the National Archives and Records Administration

(NARA). As if this was not bad enough, the items stolen were American servicemen's dog tags, and to make it worse, he sold them on EBay for over \$43,000. The 2nd man unlawfully took four tags with the intent to give them to relatives. Genealogists and researchers must be roiling that our national treasures are being pilfered, but also that <u>our</u> reputations as researchers might be sullied along with these criminals. This is how all of us get bad names in Libraries, Archives, and Courthouses. Please double your efforts to be careful when using these valuable repositories and remember we don't want to ever be refused access because of thievery.


